# **Director's Report:**

Library Move: Initial Asa Wood presentation was made for Board members and guest's feedback. Another Asa Wood presentation is scheduled for a test group July 16, 2013 at the Libby school administration building. The library website is being upgraded. Some new features on the website will include a scrolling banner on the homepage, new tabs and links to other social media such as Twitter, Facebook, YouTube, Pinterest and PayPal for donations. No launch date for the new website was given. The vision for the new library is for it to be a library information and technology center combined with a community center.

Future library design and function elements were discussed including the location of the community organizations, gym use, linking future library programs and outreach efforts with community groups such as the community garden, Koats for Kids and the food pantry.
