Reports:

Financial Report: FY22- January

110,140,148 – amounts are caught up through December 2021.

Old Business:

Strategic Goals

- Security System Update:
 - Director Ramirez spoke with County IT specialist, and unfortunately the County tabled Lincoln County Library's security project and said to speak to Grizzly Security in Kalispell.
 - o An outdated estimated cost of installation in Libby- \$8,780, with an additional annual fee. We will also receive estimates for Troy and Eureka Branches.
 - o Estimate to update all three Libraries ~ \$16,000-\$18,000.
 - We may need to look into a grant to help pay for this project.
- Capital Improvement Plan/Fund: see attached
 - o FOL (Libby) would like brighter lighting, might need to update/replace lights... up to \$9,000 for LED upgrade
 - o Look for electrical grants to update switches for better energy efficiency
 - Input into plan possibly update on floor per year
 - How do we set up this fund? Might have to speak with Wendy and County Commissioners. Barb and Alyssa will speak to County.
- **Troy Branch Exterior**: still being worked on and will get lined up for a spring building inspection.

Calendar Update:

Juneteenth- Hvizdak made motion to close Juneteenth (June 20th) as a recognized federal holiday, seconded by McDougall, approved.

Day after Thanksgiving- Question about closing or reducing hours. Board decided to keep the libraries open for normal business on November 25, 2022.

New Business:

Open Trustee Position – (at large): Rory Kane is ill today and could not be present at meeting. Hvizdak made motion to move forward with Rory Kane's Lincoln County Library Board Application, seconded by McDougall, approved.

<u>Open Eureka Substitute Position:</u> The current position only includes two hours of work per week. Opportunity to increase interest in the position and opportunity to learn the branch librarian position by hiring a temporary person, up to 3 months of work with 6 hours of work per week. Director Ramirez will move forward on a temporary 3-month hire.

<u>Lincoln County Library Foundation:</u> Traditionally the Lincoln County Library Foundation (LCLF) is the fundraising arm of volunteers and Friends of the Library (FOL) is the active volunteer arm. Mary Jo stepping down from the Foundation and would like to pass on the Treasury duties. Is there a way to combine all groups, to keep up to date with volunteers, projects, money? Need to recruit new bodies! Susan Horlick with FOL will take over the LCLF Treasury duties. Need two more people to be on the LCLF board.

Director's Report January 2022

Lincoln County Library

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten- looking to expand this program in Troy and Libby after expanding in Eureka. Currently, there are 8 local sponsors for the program including: Cabinet Peaks Family Medicine, Communities that Care, Lincoln County Library, Logan Health (Eureka Clinic), Troy Public Schools, Unite for Youth, Western Montana Mental Health Center and Zero to Five. Our goal is to distribute 300 Welcome Bags in the Libby/Troy area. Each bag includes a book, egg shaker, sticker, flyers, and fun toys that support early literacy skills. Bags should be ready to go by February 14.

Imagination Library- In partnership with Zero to Five, we are working on establishing Imagination Library in Lincoln County. In this program, a free book is mailed to children ages 0-5 every month. We pay a small portion of the cost (Zero to Five) and maintain the database of registered kids (LCL). Paperwork has been submitted to Imagination Library Headquarters. We are now waiting for approval from USPS to mail at non-profit rates. Estimated start date is March with the first book mailed in April.

Adopt-a-Magazine- Monies raised:

Eureka- \$656.36 Libby- \$1347.23

Troy-\$407.59 (FOL to adopt Economist \$225)

Adopt-a-Kid's Book- Staff raised \$950 for Adopt-a-Kid's Book program.

Challenges at ImagineIf- There are 2 ongoing issues at ImagineIf that I feel are worth bringing to the board's attention.

- Book Challenges- book challenges are sweeping the nation, and this is an alarming trend for a couple reasons. For one, many challengers haven't even read the book. Many hear from some source that certain books are "obscene" or "pornographic". They check to see if the library has a copy and challenge the book without even reading it. Second, this trend is gaining sympathy from some legislatures. In Oklahoma, a bill was put forth that if a school librarian doesn't remove a book within 30 days, he or she is fired and barred from working in a school for 2 years. At Imaginelf, 2 books are being challenged right now and has prompted some trustees to move towards extreme oversight of library functions.
- New Director Hire- the board of trustees has decided to move forward with hiring a new director that does not have her MLIS. This means ImagineIf no longer meets the Public Library Standards and is ineligible for state aid. This is a loss of \$30,000.

In support of my fellow colleagues, I have attended and spoken out at 2 library board meetings. I feel it is important to speak out because the decisions made at these meetings potentially affect other libraries and Partners.

Eureka Branch

Remodel- the Eureka branch was closed the week before Christmas to remodel the library. The library received new paint, carpet, desk, and shelving.





Interbel Upgrades- Interbel has generously agreed to fund a complete hardware upgrade at the Eureka branch, including computers, wireless access point, and other needed programs or platforms to secure the devices. This will be an estimated \$5,000 donation.

Libby Branch

Libby branch had to cancel a number of programs due to staff illness.

IT Specialist- Ethan Hoff was hired as the IT Specialist to fulfill the ARPA grant we received. He is working on a survey of current technology literacy classes offered at other libraries before working on a community-wide survey to determine the needs of Lincoln County.

Troy Branch




Sharee received her certification from the Montana State Library
